It was a leap of faith the Board made in purchasing a new home in Hibbing for SON Iron Range. The staff up there found the perfect home - but it needed renovations. We worked with Western Bank to secure a mortgage and and moved forward in late July. Our board member, Pat Larson, masterfully GC'd the project with Alesch Contracting and we were in our new home by Dec 31st. It was a bigger project than planned but we did it right and with some amazing local family funding and an ARPA grant spearheaded by Commissioner Jugovich and SLC Brian Fritsinger, we are now able to save 40% annually in our housing costs. If you want to know how good God is - he exactly nailed the renovation costs with those two sources of funding. God is AMAZING!

Of course this always comes at the time I wonder if this mission is what God wants for us to be doing. More maternity-like homes are popping up in the area and its a struggle to keep it all going. Yet someone sends us a note of support, a small or large check, drops off a wonderful donation and it is clear God says keep going with it. We have been blessed to help over 30 moms and babies and support a mom who despite being raped, chose life. Then I see the tender loving care from each of our staff and volunteers with these Mom's and babies/children and "see the Face of God" and how our faith is being poured out. That is all we can ask for as we put forth our hearts and prayers in a special way during Lent. Thank you for all your prayers and all you do for SON!
